Routines for the start of the new school year



The new Year 2 children should come to the front playground and the new Year 1 children should come to the back playground.



Start of the School Day—8:50 a.m.

You need to be in the playground just before 8:50 so that your child is ready to line up when the bell rings. The teachers will be out for the bell and the children should line up, with all their belongings, on their colour spots in their area of the playground. The class will then go into school with their teacher through either the Year 1 or Year 2 corridor door, hang up their coats in the cloakroom areas, put lunch boxes, book bags and water bottles away, and go into their classrooms. Staff are always on hand to support this.

End of the School Day—3.20 p.m.

At home time the class will come out through the same corridor door and go over to their spots. The teacher needs to identify the adult collecting each child before letting them go - so please be patient and wait for your child to say goodbye to their teacher.
