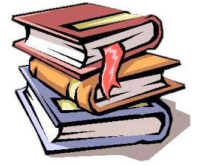




# World Book Day

Dear Parents / Carers,

At Pinner Park, we will be having a day of activities to celebrate World Book Day - looking at favourite books and authors, acting out stories, special story times and reading stories that our friends have written.

The children can join in on Thursday, 7<sup>th</sup> March by bringing a favourite book to school or making a headdress/headband relating to a favourite character or book. This can be made at home as a home activity and brought to school on the day or made at school during World Book Day. You will need just a band of card or thick paper around your child's head, then your child can draw a picture of their favourite character and decorate.

Please choose a character from a book that your child knows and can talk about. We would prefer the children to choose a character from a book, not from a film (e.g. Frozen) or a cartoon (e.g. Spiderman or Batman). These are some ideas to inspire you:

- Mr Men and Little Miss Characters
- Paddington Bear
- The Tiger who came to tea
- Characters from Julia Donaldson books (e.g. The Room on the Broom, The Gruffalo)
- Peppa Pig
- Characters from Jill Murphy books (e.g. The Large family, The Worst Witch)
- Dr Seuss characters (e.g. The Cat in the Hat)
- Characters from Traditional Tales or Nursery Rhymes (e.g. Goldilocks, Little Red Riding Hood, Alice in Wonderland, Humpty Dumpty, Little Miss Muffet)
- You also could come as a non-fiction book (e.g. a dictionary or a cookery book)
